In pursuance of the Government of Sindh Notification bearing No. SO(CTC)/SGA&CD/COVID-19/Committee/2020 dated 24.03.2020 and 08.04.2020, and Committee constituted vide Home Department, Government of Sindh Notification bearing No. SO (Jud-I)HD/8-1(04)/2020-Corona dated 28th April, 2020, the sub-committee-I examined the requests/applications received from the export-oriented industries in the light of Home Department Order No. SO(Jud-I)HD/8-1(04)/2020-Corona dated 14thApril 2020, wherein such industries were allowed to operate subject to the condition of ensuring adherence to SOPs bearing No. SO(Jud-I)HD/8-1(04)/2020-Corona/SOPs dated 14thApril 2020, issued by Home Department in view of COVID-19 measures.
