



MINUTES OF MEETING HELD UNDER CHAIRMANSHIP OF ADDITIONAL CHIEF SECRETARY, HOME DEPARTMENT, ON 06.01.2026 ON FOLLOW UP OF DECISIONS MADE IN FIRST MEETING OF IMPLEMENTATION COMMITTEE FOR DACOIT SURRENDER POLICY IN KATCHA AREA OF SUKKUR AND LARKANA DIVISIONS

The meeting was held on 06.01.2026 under chairmanship of Additional Chief Secretary (ACS), Home Department, to follow on the decisions taken in first meeting of the Implementation Committee for Dacoit Surrender Policy. Commissioner Larkana, DC Shikarpur and SSP Larkana (representing DIGP Larkana) joined the meeting online.

2. The Chair welcomed the participants and highlighted importance of implementation of the decisions with regard to socio-development on ground to success of the surrender policy. The Chair invited Commissioner Larkana and DC Shikarpur to brief on implementation status of the decisions.

3. The Commissioner Larkana briefed the meeting that they have furnished a report giving status (copy attached). He and DC Shikarpur then briefed on the steps taken in the Katcha Area of Shikarpur district, with particular focus on Garhi Tegho, as under:

- The meetings of divisional and district committees constituted for implementation of the Dacoit Surrender policy are being held regularly. The meetings are participated by all members.
- Basic Health Unit Garhi Tegho has been made operational in a makeshift space provided by local (BHU Building needs major repairs) with medical and paramedical staff posted there. OPD is run on regular basis.
- Twenty medical camps have been organized in the Katcha area, by Health Department and PPHI Sindh, to provide routine and maternal healthcare.
- An Ambulance, along with staff, is deployed 24/7 in the Katcha area to cater to any referral or health emergency.
- Fourteen schools in the area are made functional with teachers posted and students enrolled. Classes are run on regular basis.
- Vets are also deployed in the area to provide veterinary services on regular basis.
- NADRA MRV visits the area to help locals have their CNICs issued and resolve the ancillary issues.
- Extension wing of Agriculture Department is working to help locals have HARI cards to benefit from the future government schemes launched in agriculture sector.


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- District administration visits the area and meets with locals to assure them of Government of Sindh support.
- A full day camp activities are planned in this week in the area where all relevant departments under DC Shikarpur will visit for provision of various services.

4. The SSP Larkana also endorsed the developments as narrated by District Administration. The Chair appreciated the works carried out by Commissioner Larkana and DC Shikarpur and their teams and asked for a very comprehensive report along with pictures and videos may be sent to Home Department for record.

5. The Commissioner Larkana stated that they have worked out a development proposal in three districts (Shikarpur, Kashmore and Larkana) amounting to Rs. 1.75 Billion which is shared with Home Department. He requested for early processing of the proposal. The meeting was informed that the proposal will be placed before the Joint Committee constituted under chair of Minister for Home department for review and approval. The Chair directed Home Department officials to submit request to Minister Home Department for convening of the Joint Committee meeting where Commissioner Larkana and Sukkur may present their proposals.

6. After detailed deliberations it was decided that:

- a) The development proposals forwarded by Commissioner Larkana and Sukkur may be submitted before the Joint Committee for review and approval; and
- b) A comprehensive report will be furnished to Home Department by DC Shikarpur along with pictures and videos for record.
